STEPS TO STUDY IN FRANCE

Compose your study project

1

Prepare your studies' project

Begin with identifying the field of study in which you would like to evolve. It must reflect your aspirations and skills. Define your professional project that is related to the chosen studies.



Search for your study programs

Once your studies' project is defined, it is necessary to implement it, which means to look concretely for the desired programs.

It is necessary to determine the motivations of your studies' project and the choice of programs, this will be asked when you will proceed with the applications.

Identity document - ID passport and a recent photograph



Study background

- For 2019 graduates (baccalaureate: thanaweya amma, IGCSE, American diploma...): 1st and 2nd year secondary school transcripts
- For those who already have the baccalaureate: transcripts of the baccalaureate, the records of any other diplomas obtained afterwards and a certificate of registration for the current year

All documents must be in French or English (or translated by a sworn translator).



CV and motivation letter



Language skills

- For study programs taught in French: DELF B2, DALF C1/DALF C2 or TCF DAP.
- For study programs taught in English: IELTS, TOEFL or TOEIC.

A B2 level is recommended, however some institutions require a higher level (C1 or C2).

Check the level of French required by each university/school!

APPLY FOR A UNIVERSITY IN FRANCE

I am a candidate

1. Log into the Etudes en France application with a valid email address and create a file **I am a candidate**
2. Enter the personal information, scan and upload the supporting documents.
Fill in the personal data, previous diplomas and courses, certifications in French and/or in English (B2 level minimum)
3. Fill in **the Training Basket** with your program choices and motivations.

Select the study program – **maximum 7 choices** all programs included:

- Licence 1 (Year 1 Bac + 1) = **maximum 3 choices** (classified by priority)
- School of architecture (ENSA) = **maximum 2 choices** (classified by priority)
- DUT = **maximum 7 choices**
- Licence 2, licence 3, Masters = **maximum 7 choices**

4. Submit your application electronically to Campus France Egypt. Campus France will check your file and you will receive an invitation for an interview and the details of payment for the administrative fees.

*Attention: make sure to observe the submission deadlines.
After the application deadline, it will no longer be possible to apply!*

For any program that is not connected with Campus France, **visit the site of the university** for the prerequisites and the corresponding procedure.

For holders of a French baccalaureate (S, ES, L) wishing to apply in first year in France, applications are made through **Parcoursup** platform.

ATTEND THE APPLICATION INTERVIEW

Pay the application fees on the day of your interview. Payment should be made in cash, at the cashier of the French Institute in Egypt.

(2018/2019 fees: **1100 LE**)

Attend your application interview with Campus France Egypt.

After the interview, the application process is over.

Check your account to see the answers given by the institutions.


Once accepted by a university, validate your choice and finalize the pre-consular procedure in the **I am accepted** tab.

You can then pick up the CEF acceptance letter at the Campus France Egypt office to submit your application for long-term student visa to TLS Contact.



The procedures of Campus France do not guarantee obtaining a pre-registration or issuing a visa.

APPLY FOR A STUDY VISA

 **I am accepted**

You can start the pre-consular procedures of Campus France as soon as you have obtained a pre-registration (at the earliest 3 months before your date of departure to France).

You cannot go directly to TLS Contact without going through Campus France procedures

1. Log into the Etudes en France application with a valid email address and create a file **I am accepted**
2. Enter the personal information, scan and upload the supporting documents.
Fill in the personal data, previous courses and diplomas, certifications in French and/or in English.
3. Indicate the study program and scan the supporting documents (certificate of acceptance of the institution).
Indicate the dates of your stay and your motivations.
4. Submit your file to Campus France Egypt. You will then receive an invitation to a pre-consular interview.
5. Pay the application fees at the cashier of the French Institute in Egypt (550 LE) and attend your pre-consular interview. After the interview, Campus France Egypt will give you your **CEF acceptance certificate** in an envelope to attach to your visa application file for the French Consulate (TLS Contact).
